

expected that this would take some time before both aspects come to fruition.

Locally Staffordshire NARPO has a problem in that Kevin Waters, our Branch Secretary has announced that he intends to stand down at the AGM in March 2026. Although the position has been advertised to our members, so far no volunteer has been forthcoming.

This has created a real headache for the Executive of Staffordshire NARPO, because National Rules state that the Branch cannot operate without a secretary. What might follow from this is that the Branch might cease to exist.

The Executive Committee are working hard to resolve the problem, and as an interim measure Joe Molloy, the Webmaster has offered to be the nominal Secretary until such time that we can recruit another permanent Secretary.

I submitted a paper to the Board of Directors of NARPO on 5/2/2026 requesting, if possible, that they provide Staffordshire Branch with some administrative support to get the Branch through its current predicament. The Board were receptive to the situation and agreed to work with us until we find a replacement.

Until such time that we can resolve this problem, members may find that the Branch service to members may be affected.

Update on Inspector Hugh Lupton.

Following on from my previous article concerning Hugh Lupton, I have been able to obtain some more information, which completes his policing story.

He married Edna May Rowell on 13/7/1946, but they do not appear to have had any children.

I had ascertained that his last station whilst a serving officer in the Staffordshire County Police was at Brierley Hill Police Station. On 1/4/1966 a amalgamation of Police Forces took place and Brierley Hill Police Station, along with other Staffordshire County Stations, were consumed by the



West Midlands Constabulary.

I was struggling to find out if Hugh Lupton transferred to the West Midlands Constabulary or chose to remain in Staffordshire County.

As a last resort I contacted the West Midlands Police Museum in Birmingham requesting their assistance. Amazingly and very quickly they got back to me, having located his original personal file, which was stored in their archive. They provided me with a photograph taken when he first joined Staffordshire County Police on 15/4/1939 and were able to confirm that he retired from Brierley Hill Police Station on 20/11/1966. I have now established that he died in North Wales on 23/10/2000

## From the Archive

### Captain William Congreve Chief Constable of Staffordshire 1866 - 1889



CC William Congreve

When William Congreve became Chief Constable of Staffordshire in 1866 he moved his family from his ancestral home, Burton Hall near to Tarvin in Cheshire to live in Stafford, he is recorded as residing at The Hollies in Newport Road. The house still stands and is today a veterinary practice.

He had previously served with the 4th Regiment of Foot leaving the army in the rank of captain when he became Staffordshire's Chief Constable in 1866, age 34. He retired from the police service in 1889 and returned to Burton Hall where he died in January 1902.

When I looked into the life of Captain Congreve I could not help but notice how the type of person that makes a chief constable has changed. Captain Congreve was from a wealthy family, whilst not aristocracy he was most definitely landed gentry. Having a military background was seen as an essential quality for the job of chief constable, for with it came the supposed ability to handle large numbers of men as in a police force and at The Hollies he had house servants, three plus a nurse in 1871 and four plus two nurses in 1881. The nurses were to care for babies born at the time of each census.

William Congreve had married Fanny Emma Townshend in 1862 and together they had six children, the eldest Walter had a distinguished military career. He was commissioned into the Rifle Brigade and with his regiment saw action in the Boer War. At the battle of Colenso he was wounded whilst attempting to save the guns abandoned by the artillery; he also attempted to rescue a wounded officer. For his actions on this day he was awarded the Victoria Cross.

Walter Congreve bought a house in the shadow of the castle at Stowe-by-Chartley and continued to serve in the army. By the time of the Great War he was a Major General and would command 6th Division. He finished the war as a Lieutenant General commanding XIII Corps and had been rewarded with knighthood. He was a front-line general evidenced when he was injured by shrapnel resulting in the loss of his left hand and he was well thought of by those under his command. With the end of hostilities he became Governor General of Malta; he died in office in February 1927 and was buried at sea.

Walter Congreve had married in 1890 Celia LaTouche, they would have three children, the eldest William, born in 1891, followed in his fathers' footsteps by becoming an officer in the Rifle Brigade and he went on to serve in the Great War. He was a capable officer and by December 1915 he was Brigade Major of 76th Brigade. Over several days in July 1916 he went out onto the battlefield with a medical officer helping to bring in the wounded, something he did despite suffering from the effects of gas. Having recovered a little he returned

to the front line trenches to determine the situation after an unsuccessful attack and there he was sadly shot and killed by a German sniper. Having already been awarded the Distinguished Service Order and the Military Cross he was now awarded the Victoria Cross. This made Walter and William Congreve one of only three fathers and sons to be awarded our country's highest award for gallant.

## **Research and Contribution of Alan Lewis [Stafford and Stone]**
